

Wine tasting at the US Embassy

US Ambassador Ann Wagner last week hosted the third Celebration of American Wine event at her residence in Limpertsberg. As always, Caves Bernard-Massard - represented by Hubert and Françoise Clasen - was on hand to provide a selection of the American wines it



brings to the Luxembourg market in partnership with Euro-Vins. But last week's event also saw, for the first time, local Moselle wines join those from across the Atlantic on the tasting tables. "A testament to our deep and long-lasting friendship," Wagner said of this new tradition.

Wagner acknowledged the importance of the Luxembourg market for US wine exports – together with Belgium it accounts for \$13.4 million in sales of what is an \$800 million export market. The EU, on the other hand, exports some \$2.6 billion to the USA per year.

Guests included representatives of the political, cultural and business world in Luxembourg as well as diplomats and the press and sommeliers from some of the country's leading restaurants.
